The 13th Man Scholarship honors the memory of Mr. Everett E. Kelly and will be referred to as the Everett E. Kelly 13th Man Scholarship. Each scholarship recipient will be awarded \$2,500.00 paid directly to the school of choice.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be High School Senior in good standing
- Must be a registered member of the 13th Man by December 31, 2025
- Must have minimum GPA of 2.5 (equivalent to a letter grade of C or better)

Scholarship Application Requirements:

- Must have 2-3 recommendations with at least one from a teacher of a core subject
- Include details on extracurricular activities
- Series of extended short answer questions.
- Questions include:
 - What lessons have you learned being a 13th Man member and how will you continue to build upon those lessons to build *your* legacy?
 - How will pursuing post-secondary education benefit you?
 - In what ways have you exhibited leadership in your life (School, community, etc.)?
 - How do you resist mediocrity?
 - Describe your most meaningful experience as a 13th Man member and how it impacted you.
